MUSCAT

What grape is red but white wine all over? Made from the red New York Muscat grape this is an extraordinary white wine. The full flavour and pronounced bouquet of the Muscat make it an ideal wine with many spicy oriental dishes, lobster, and heavy stews. It is also the best wine for steaming mussels, giving them a wonderful flavour.

NOSE:

Considered one of the most distinct and recognizable grapes, the Muscat family is famous for its intense and aromatic notes of rose, lychee, kiwi and fruit blossom.

PALATE:

Spicy, vibrant, eclectic, stone fruit, marmalade, rose water, touch of ginger and maybe thyme/sage.

NOTES:

Medium light body, yet with a lot going on, keeps developing and each sip reveals new nuances. Definitely food friendly. Served chilled it is the quintessential summer wine!
