## Gaspereau Vineyards Riesling

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*The grapes for this 100% Nova Scotian Riesling are from the Annapolis Valley's Gaspereau Estate, Black Dogs and Warner's Vineyards. The classic characteristics of apple and lime, a bright backbone of acidity, and an off-dry finish make a perfect pairing with goat cheese or pork.*

### **nose:**

The nose shows a distinct mineral note interwoven with classic apple and floral aromas and a hint of white pepper. The aromatics on the nose elude to a classic Riesling palate; one that achieves balance between vibrant acidity and just the right touch of sweetness.

### **palate:**

True to the impression given on the nose, the palate reveals a freshness and minerality that only Riesling grown in a cool climate can achieve. Gaspereau Vineyards' Riesling 2013 is a blend of Riesling grown in three distinct locations in the Annapolis Valley: Gaspereau Estate, Black Dogs and Warner's vineyards. Combining these unique terroir, create a truly Nova Scotian Riesling. Notes of green apple and white pepper dominate the palate of this wine, a character contributed by the Warner Vineyard component of this Riesling while apple and kiwi notes with floral undertones are expressed more in the Gaspereau Estate component. The Black Dogs component mirrors the Gaspereau profile with added notes of dried apricot and a soft acidity. Minerality is a pillar of this wine and is exhibited to varying degrees in all three base wines.

### **notes:**

Riesling finishes with a refreshing acidity, a lingering apple and mineral note and a balanced sweetness, making this off dry wine perfectly food-friendly. Ideal pairings include cream and broth-based soups, pork roasts, seafood, sushi and various fresh cheeses.
